Today I begin a series of sermons on the Lord's Prayer. We begin with the acknowledgement that God is holy. The opening sentence of the prayer says, "hallowed be thy name." Holiness means separateness; God calls us to be a holy people who are set apart; when we celebrate communion, our prayers are that the bread and wine would be set apart from their ordinary purpose. A holy God is one from whom we keep a proper distance.

We will visit the parts of this prayer throughout the summer: two weeks in each month of June, July, and August. I hope we might learn something new as we hear the petitions of this prayer.
