Work on the Interfaith Build has begun! We will be working on the Interfaith home at 2207 11th St. West in Bradenton three mornings a week (Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday). Anyone who wishes to join us on the job site need only let me know. We can incorporate 1-2 casual volunteers almost any morning.

Due to child labor regulations, volunteers need to be 16 or older. All volunteers need to fill out a waiver (attached) and those under 18 must have it signed by a parent or guardian.

The work you may expect to be engaged in includes: digging, painting, landscaping, loading and unloading building materials, siding, roofing, hammering, framing, or installing flooring. No experience is needed and we will have competent volunteers to guide you in any tasks.

The work time at the construction site on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday is 7:30 am to noon and we can provide all the needed equipment: hard hats, safety glasses, shovels, rakes, work gloves (bring your own if you like). We also provide a non-smoking/non-vaping job site. A light snack will be provided mid-morning. We encourage all volunteers to eat a hearty breakfast to fuel them through the morning's work. Please wear closed toed shoes; no flip flops or sandals allowed. Also wear clothing you don't mind getting dirty. Please no tank tops. Shorts should be a modest length. Please note that cell phone usage should be limited to emergency calls during the work period.
